- Resource assessed Grade 8s with DIbels: common assessment, easy to use, 1 minute timed reading.
  - o 71% in Grade 8 at risk of challenges with basic literary skills requiring small group intervention.
  - o Tier 3 interventions during tutorial 3 times per week
  - o Need elementary intervention
- How do we build background knowledge in the classroom
  - o Invite students to think about and share their prior knowledge: anticipation guides, KWL charts
  - Share short clips or videos to build background knowledge
  - o Display caption-less pictures: What do you notice? What do you wonder?
  - Read short articles or pieces of literature that further build student understanding
  - Use music, podcasts, short essays or new clips to provide informational, historical or cultural context
- School improvement day Hannah Beach
  - o Emphasis on the need for emotional safety and connection in supporting students with anxiety
  - Look behind the behaviour especially at the high school level
- Projects for 2025/26
  - New flooring on 2nd floor
  - Phase to of front of school
  - Fields services 2x per year
  - New tech added 2 laptop carts
  - New tech for resource dept.
  - New murals
  - New furniture in classrooms and courtyard
  - New resources for reading interventions
  - New school legacy project tv
  - New lighting upgrades to both gyms
  - More flexible hallway furniture
