

- West Langley is a K-7 school nestled in the community of Walnut Grove.

UNIFIED ACTIONS:

- Implement RTI blocks with common assessments
- PLC time each week engaging in collaborative planning and data informed instruction
- Explicit SEL instruction using Kelso's Choice, Zones of Regulation and MindUP
- Complex Trauma resources – Calm Classrooms
- Provide Tier 2 and Tier 3 SEL supports (sensory room, calm corners in classrooms, focused small group intervention with CYCW)
- Co-teaching model with itinerant staff
- K-2 Early Intervention for Learning Assistance
- PEACEful schools checklist
- Participation in the Entrepreneur & Innovation Project
- Integrate K-7 Career Education curricular competencies by supporting student goal-setting and facilitating exploration of community roles to build awareness of future possibilities.
