

Choir Code of Conduct

1. Choir students are expected to be prompt for rehearsals.
2. For safety reasons, Ms. Dotto requires an email when students will be absent from choir.
3. Choir students are expected to use the bathroom and drink their water before choir rehearsals begin and only ask to use the facilities during rehearsal if it is an emergency.
4. Choir students are expected to treat the music room with respect and wait quietly along the walls before rehearsal (no running, yelling, balls, etc.).
5. Choir students are expected to come prepared and practiced for rehearsal (learning lyrics, practicing parts, etc.).
6. Choir students are expected to try their best at each rehearsal (respectful to helping teachers, saving questions to the end, maintaining focus, etc.).
7. Choir students are expected to be polite, responsible, and respectful members of our school community.
8. There is a zero-tolerance for bullying amongst choir students and their peers at Willoughby.
9. Choir students are expected to come to performances in the proper performance attire (concert blacks), with their hair pulled back.
10. During choir performances, choir students are expected to wait “backstage” quietly.

Warning and Strike Policy

Should a choir student miss 3 or more rehearsals unexcused, or are unable to uphold the Choir Code of Conduct, they will be issued a warning.

1 warning = verbal warning only

2nd warning= an email home

3rd warning = strike

Strike = having to sit out of one choir rehearsal

4th warning = sit out of rehearsal again and have a meeting with Ms. Dotto and the parents or guardian of the choir student to develop a plan moving forward.
