Kindergarten and new student registration across the Langley School District runs from January 5 – February 17, 2026. If your child will be five years old by December 31, 2026, or if your family is moving to the catchment for the 2026-27 school year, you will be able to register online. ## Weather and Appropriate Clothing:

### INCLEMENT WEATHER INFORMATION



The weather forecast for the coming weeks is quite different from what we have experienced recently. We wanted to remind you to ensure your children are appropriately dressed for the cold and wet days that are now upon us. Please be advised that we send our students outside for fresh air, even during rainy and snowy days. We know you would agree that fresh air and exercise are good for children, but they need to be dressed appropriately (e.g., boots, toques, gloves or mittens and warm jackets with hoods). We ask that ALL students have an extra change of clothes (shirt, pants, and socks) in their backpacks in case they get wet during recess or lunchtime play. **We also ask that you label your child's clothing jackets/sweaters/coats with his/her first name, so we can return lost items (our Lost & Found is always overflowing!)** We appreciate and thank you for your attention to this matter.

### **Information About School Status During Inclement Weather**

*Snow closures and power outages are an annual occurrence in the Langley School District. So, where do you go to get information about the status of schools during periods of inclement weather? If you are able to access the internet via computer or smartphone, current information about Langley schools can be accessed on all school websites or [www.sd35.bc.ca](http://www.sd35.bc.ca). Updates are also posted to X (formerly Twitter) @LangleySchools and Facebook at [www.facebook.com/langleyschooldistrict](http://www.facebook.com/langleyschooldistrict). If you don't have internet connectivity but your phone is working, call a relative or friend in an area that has not been affected by the storm and ask them to check the district website for you. Local radio stations are also informed of the school status in Langley. Tune in to CKWX 1130AM, CKNW 980AM, Country Radio 107.1FM, Pulse 107.7 or CBC 690AM or 88.1FM for updates.*



*Please note that Langley District schools are all considered 'open' until a decision to close is required. Decisions on school closures are usually made by 6:30am. As always, it is a parent's decision whether to send their child to school based on safety and individual circumstances. If you feel it is unsafe for you or your child to travel to or attend an open school for any reason, please keep your child home and report an absence to the school.*
