Concert Blacks:

Choir students are expected to wear their “concert blacks” for our performances. Concert blacks look like: black shoes, black bottoms, black skirt, black dress, black tights, black top, black suit, etc. Concert blacks look best when they are “fancy”. This means button-down shirts, dress shoes, dress pants, etc. Hoodies, jeans, sneakers, or any other street wear is not recommended for concert attire. Please note that long hair should be tied back for performances (half-up/half-down is okay).



Concert Days:

When our school concerts fall on the same day as choir, there will be no choir rehearsal after school.

Practice and Attendance:



In order for our choir to do awesome things (concerts, festival, school assemblies, etc.), a certain amount of commitment and hard work is expected. This can look like: learning lyrics in a timely manner, practicing at home, practicing with Ms. Dotto’s practice tracks, and a good attendance record.
