What

Work And Volunteer Experience (WAVE) is a four-credit Grade 12 elective course focusing on career exploration. Students complete assignments to prepare them to work, volunteer and/or job shadow for 80-170 hours at an employer's place(s) of business.

Why

- Complete course credits outside of a school in an area of interest
- Start with a new employer or continue where you are already working/volunteering
- Acquire skills and experience employers want
- Get a head start on your career
- Have a smoother transition from school to work
- Potential to be offered paid employment with employers
- Take more than nine courses in a school year, does not impact current school schedule
- Find your own employer or connect with the assistance of a teacher
- Earn up to eight elective credits towards graduation (equals two courses)
- Get paid or gain volunteer experience while earning school graduation credits
- Gain experience in almost any industry/occupation

When

- Complete work after school, weekends, and holiday, including winter, spring and summer break
- Best to register during course selection
- Can sign up during the school year

Who

- Be in grade 10-12
- Have parent/guardian permission (if under 19)
- Follow expectations from SD35, your school and your employer
- Work/volunteer up to 170 hours with an employer
- Arrange your own transportation to/from the employer
- Complete school requirements in order to participate in a placement

Where

- There are two parts for this course. What you do for school and what you do for the employer.
 - Schoolwork will be done with your WAVE teacher in school or online
 - Placement will be at the employer's their place(s) of business



Through WAVE, students will observe and practice employability skills, as well as skills specific to occupations, industries, or careers. Other goals of WAVE include helping students to:			
Course Description	 pursue academic and career-life goals. facilitate the transition from school to post-secondary life. understand the responsibilities and expectations associated with a work experience placement. develop employment readiness and sector-specific skills. understand the responsibilities and expectations of a workplace. 			
	WAVE is a deep experiential learning course that takes place both in and out of the classroom. Students will complete approximately 110-200 hours of learning with approximately 20 hours of classroom preparation and reflection and 80-170 hours of work placements in authentic work environments. All four sections are mandatory to earn a grade in this course.
