- ✓ Fort Langley Elementary is a neighborhood school located in the heart of historic Fort Langley, near the Kwantlen First Nation community.
- ✓ Our school is part of the DW Poppy family of schools and currently enrolls 294 students in Kindergarten to Grade 7.
- ✓ In 2017, FLE added Outdoor Education classes as part of its programming. Students K-7 from around the district have the opportunity to sign up for this unique learning experience. This program is also known as "LEAP" (Learning Environmental Awareness Program).
