# Travelling with a Certified Team/Organization Checklist

Students who are new to our program are covered by Study Insured insurance until they can be put on MSP. Students without a study permit remain on Study Insured. Study Insured does not cover high risk activities including but not limited to driving any type of motorized vehicle on land, water or air, bungee jumping, rock/cliff climbing, etc. Students <u>may not</u> participate activities which are not covered by Study Insured.

The following information is included in the application:

- □ Signatures of Natural Parent, Homestay & School Coordinator
- ☐ Government Issued Photo ID of the Chaperone (proof of age)
- □ Copy of the Criminal Record check of the Chaperone
- □ If flying, the Student's plane ticket or confirmation
- □ If flying and/or travelling outside of Canada, a letter from Natural parents stating that the student can travel with the Chaperone.
- □ For high-risk activity, a company waiver signed by the natural parent (not permitted for students on Study Insured)
- □ Proof of additional insurance (students on MSP, if travelling out of BC)
- □ I have checked the expiration dates of all relevant travel documents listed below. The documents do not expire in the 3 months prior to my return date.

The student must take the following on the trip:

- BC Medical Card
- Study Insured Card (valid in Canada & US)

In addition, if flying and/or travelling out of Canada the student must take the following valid documents:

- Passport
- Study Permit
- LOA
- Letter from Natural parents stating that the student can travel with the Chaperone
- Travel visa, if necessary
- Custodian document
