## ALICE BROWN SCHOLARSHIP

Alice Brown Elementary School was officially opened on November 18, 1977. Our neighbourhood school was named in honour of a woman who was an outstanding teacher and administrator for years in the Langley School District. Although we are located on the outskirts of Brookswood, we are the only City of Langley school with a K-7 population of approximately 260 students.

Alice Brown's educational philosophy is based on the belief that our school is a welcoming, safe and caring place where students, parents and staff are committed to learning. The dignity of every individual is upheld. Cooperative attitudes and a focus on the positive help students build their self-esteem. Alice Brown is a community of learners where students, parents and staff wish to be.

## **CRITERIA**

The award will be granted annually to a student in Grade 12 in a public school in Langley who attended Alice Brown Elementary for at least one school year. The following must be submitted:

- a) A completed Alice Brown Scholarship application form showing specific plans as to immediate future academic, technical or vocational education or training.
- b) Written confirmation from your school principal or counsellor on school letterhead that you will be graduating in June 2025.
- c) An essay of 250 words or more regarding: "The Most Important Thing I Learned at Alice Brown"
- d) Graduating students from Langley School District #35 are eligible to apply who attended Alice Brown Elementary for at least one school year (please provide the date(s) of attendance).
- e) The applicant must agree to have their essay published in a newspaper, on a web site, PAC, BCCPAC or DPAC publications.

For the 2024/2025 school year, an award in the amount of \$500 will be given to a student entering or involved in ANY FIELD OF STUDY. The Alice Brown Elementary Scholarship Committee Chairperson must receive completed applications by 3pm, Friday, May 30, 2025.
