Students will learn about occupations related to the Piping/Plumbing industry and will be involved in some hands-on activities with current students.

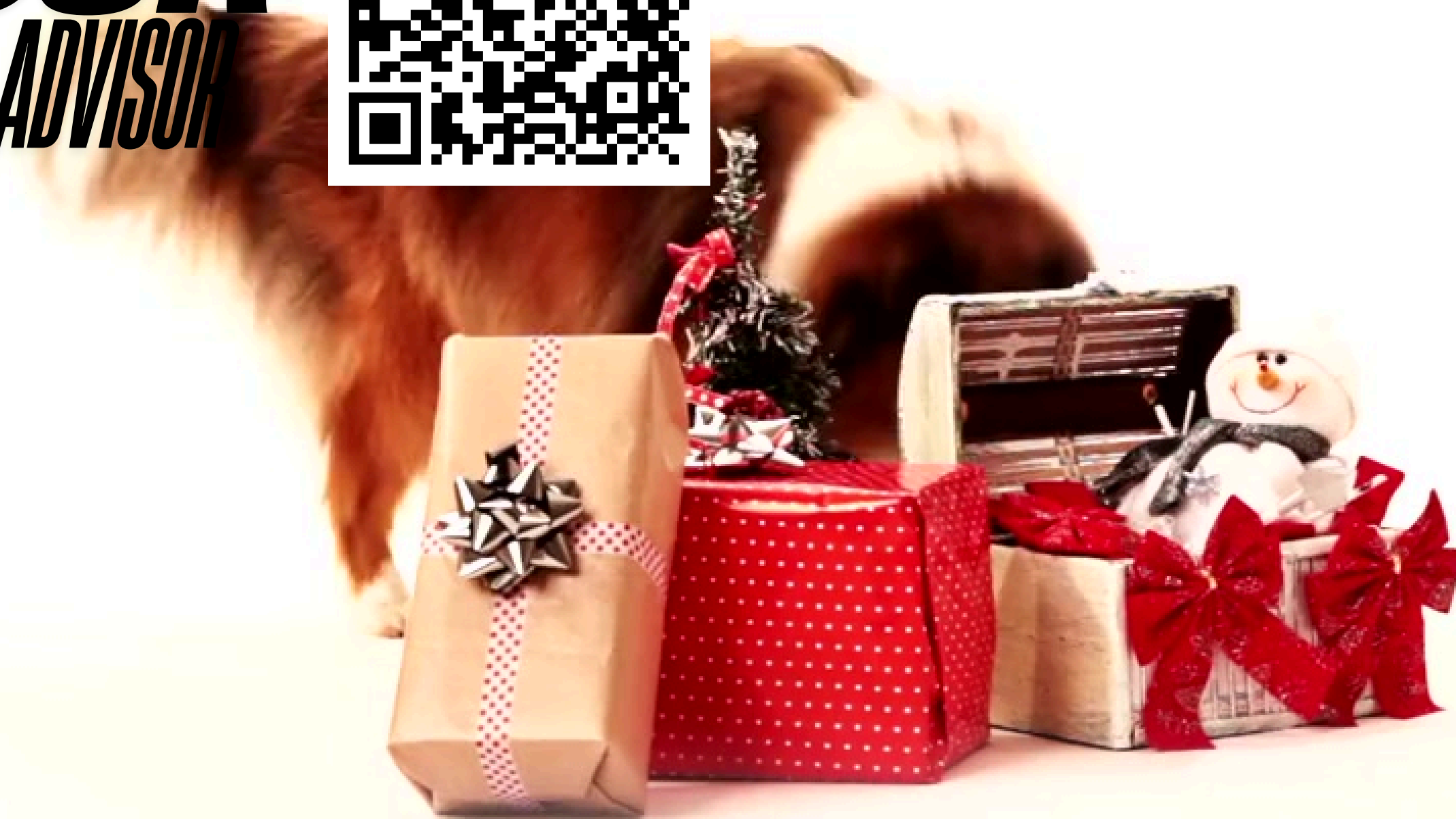

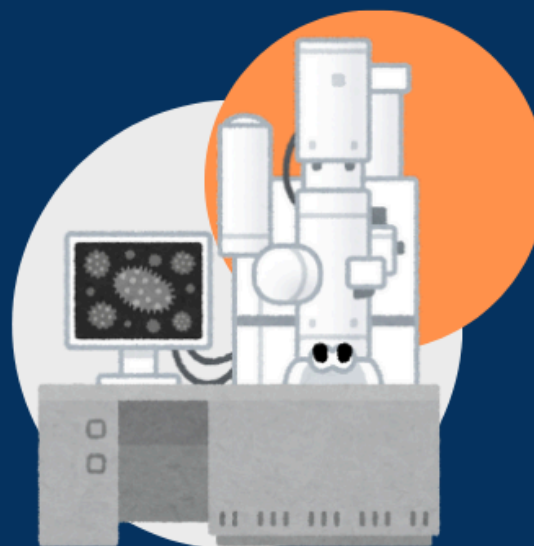
