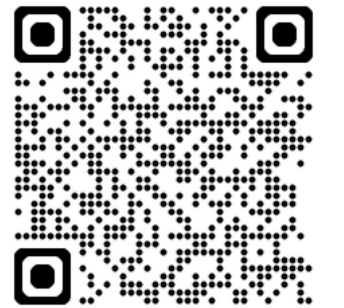

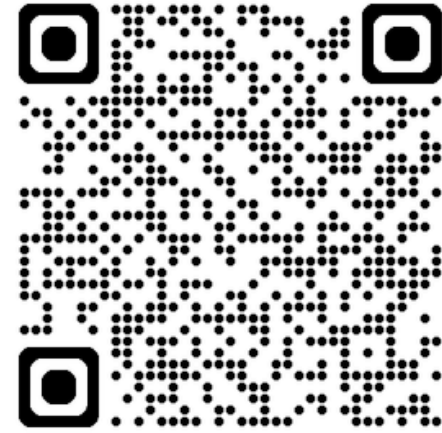

- Visual & Fine Arts studios that accommodate many specialties

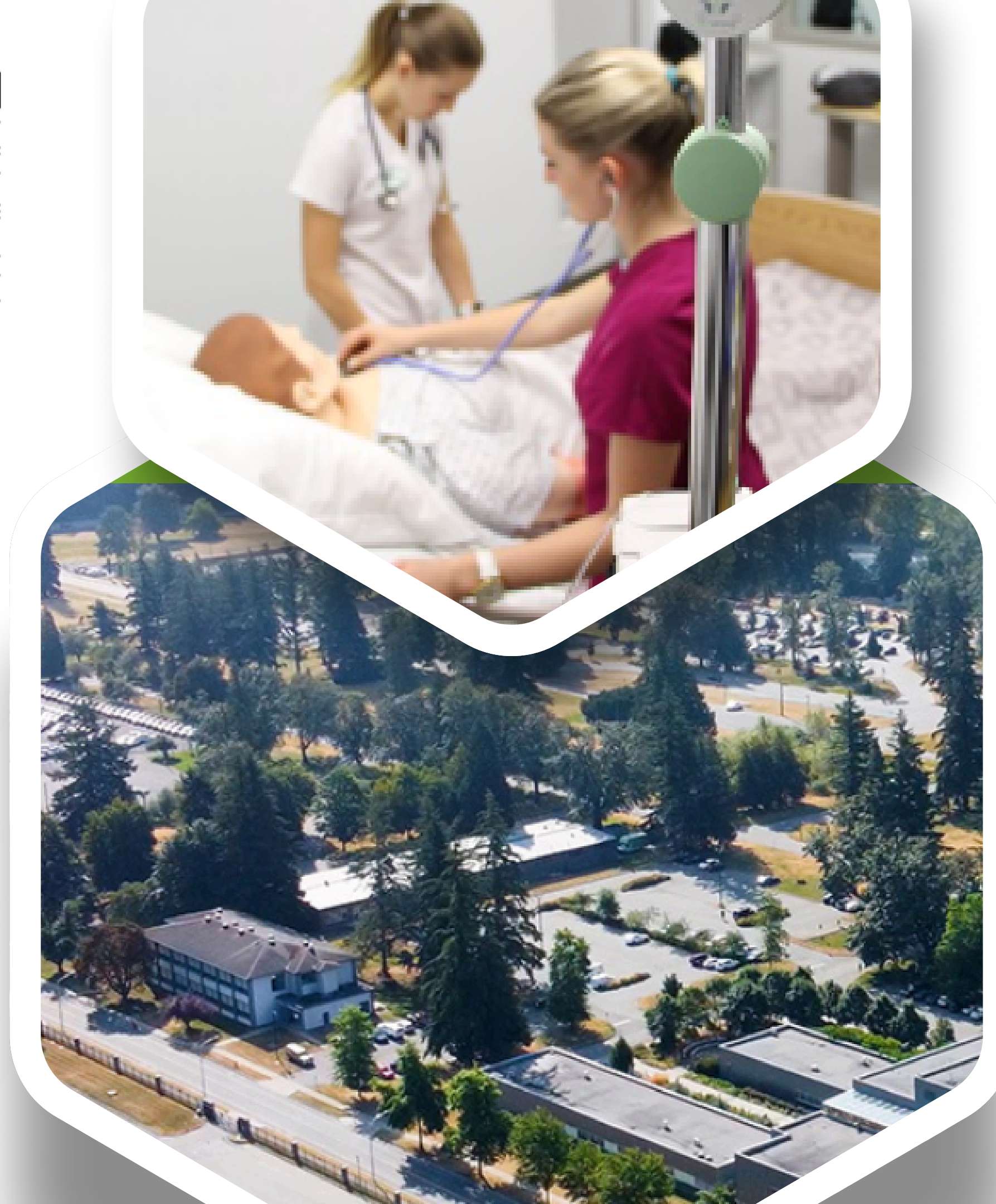

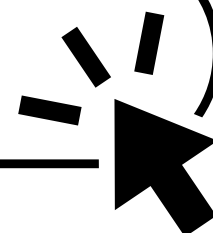
YOUTH OUTREACH MENTORSHIP PROGRAM

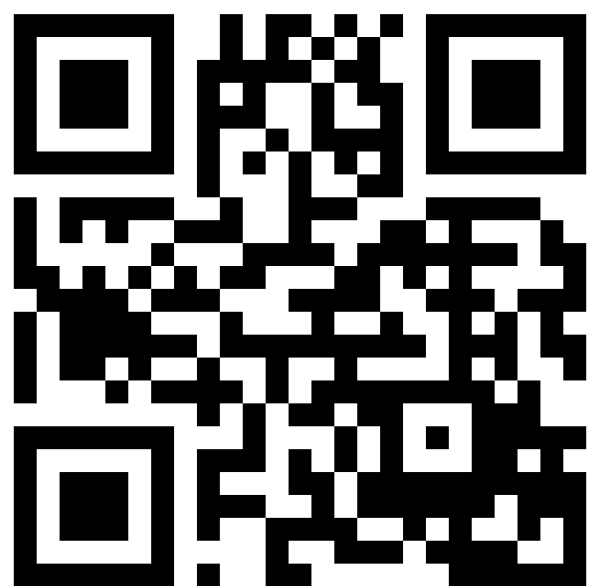




Summer Student Research Program
