All participants receive a certificate, with chances to earn Gold, Silver, or Bronze awards.

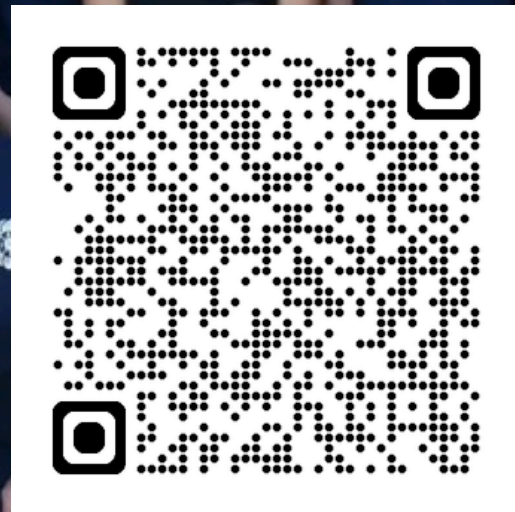
