



## AM I ON TRACK TO GRADUATE?

### READING A DIPLOMA VERIFICATION REPORT

1. All 17 boxes at the top and all must be checked for you to meet graduation requirements. These are compulsory courses and assessments you have completed, plus those on your current timetable that must still be completed  
\*The LTA12-Literacy 12 Graduation Assessment will be unchecked and you will get an opportunity to write this assessment  
\*\*If a box is not checked and you feel you have met that requirement or if there is another error, please see your counsellor.
2. Check the bottom of the report beside “# of credits at the grade 12 level”. It should be 16 or more in the far right column.
3. Check the number beside “Total Credits”. It should be at least 80 in the far right column.

Column 1 = how many you have completed

Column 2 = how many are in progress (based on your schedule)

Column 3 = how many potential credits you will have if all the ones in progress are completed.

*\*Transcript Verification Reports (TVR) will be handed out in November for students to review.*

<b>Douglas College</b>	October 1 <sup>st</sup>	Limited intake programs offer seats to qualified applicants before the application deadline of May 31 <sup>st</sup> deadline	March 31 <sup>st</sup>
<b>KPU</b>	October 1 <sup>st</sup>	Limited intake programs fill quickly; plan to apply before March 1 <sup>st</sup> deadline	March 31 <sup>st</sup>
<b>BCIT</b>	October 1 <sup>st</sup>	Open until program filled; then name on waitlist	April 15 <sup>th</sup>
<b>UFV</b>	October 1 <sup>st</sup>	Applications should be submitted ASAP. Programs that have competitive entry may have a specific deadline date to apply.	March 10 <sup>th</sup>
<b>UBC</b>	Early October	December 1 <sup>st</sup> (for first round offers) January 15 <sup>th</sup> is final application deadline	December 1 <sup>st</sup>
<b>UVIC</b>	September 1 <sup>st</sup>	January 31 <sup>st</sup>	March 15 <sup>th</sup>
<b>SFU</b>	October 1 <sup>st</sup>	January 31 <sup>st</sup>	December 15 <sup>th</sup>

*All applications to Ontario Universities must be submitted through a common application centre, the OUAC (Ontario University Application Centre). Students submit one online application that will be forwarded to each specific school you select. Students from BC should use form 105 when applying.*

*Application deadlines vary from school to school and from program to program. You should check specific university websites to confirm. Generally speaking, deadlines vary from mid January to late February.*

*Entrance requirements also vary greatly from school to school and program to program.*

### **HOW CAN I SEND MY TRANSCRIPTS TO POST-SECONDARY INSTITUTIONS?**

**All grade 12s are required to register with the BC Ministry of Education's Student Transcript Service.** Once you register with the STS, the Ministry will send your current transcript to the post-secondary schools that you designate. The system will then send an additional interim transcript in the Spring, and a final transcript in late July.

Instructions on how to register for the STS are attached and will also be on Grade 12 Counselling Info. Teams Channel. Registering with the STS is a Career Life Connections (CLC) requirement and counsellors will be visiting your classes on October 18<sup>th</sup>.

#### **\*\*Those taking CLC in Second Semester\*\***

There will be 2 REP periods where you will meet in the Learning Commons to get signed up. **It is your responsibility to make sure you attend.**
