

AM I ON TRACK TO GRADUATE?



READING A DIPLOMA VERIFICATION REPORT

1. All 18 boxes at the top must be checked for you to meet graduation requirements. These are compulsory courses and assessments you must complete to meet graduation requirements.

*The LTA12-Literacy 12 Graduation Assessment will be unchecked and you will get an opportunity to write this assessment

**If a box is blank and you feel you have met that requirement (or if there is another error), please see your counsellor.

2. Check the bottom of the report beside “# of credits at the grade 12 level”. It should be 16 or more in the far right column.
3. Check the number beside “Total Credits”. It should be at least 80 in the far right column.

Column 1 = how many you have completed

Column 2 = how many are in progress (based on your schedule)

Column 3 = how many potential credits you will have *if all the ones in progress are completed*.

**Transcript Verification Reports (TVR) will be handed out in November for students to review.*

INSTITUTION	APPLICATION OPENS	ADMISSION DEADLINE	SCHOLARSHIP DEADLINE
Douglas College	October 1 st	Limited intake programs offer seats to qualified applicants before the application deadline of May 31 st	March 31 st
KPU	October 1 st	Limited intake programs fill quickly; plan to apply before March 1 st deadline	October 15-April 15
BCIT	October 1 st	Open until program filled & then name on waitlist; some open throughout year	April 15 th
UFV	October 1 st	Applications should be submitted ASAP. Programs that have competitive entry may have a specific deadline date to apply.	March 10 th
UBC	Early October	January 15 th is final application deadline	December 1 st
UVIC	September 1 st	January 31 st	March 15 th
SFU	October 1 st	January 31 st	December 15 th

HOW CAN I SEND MY TRANSCRIPTS TO POST-SECONDARY INSTITUTIONS?

All grade 12s are required to register with the BC Ministry of Education's Student Transcript Service. Once you register with the STS, the Ministry will send your current transcript to the post-secondary schools that you designate. The system will then send an additional interim transcript in the Spring, and a final transcript in late July.

Instructions on how to register for the STS are attached and will also be on Grade 12 Counselling Info. Teams Channel. Registering with the STS is a Career Life Connections (CLC) requirement. Counsellors visited CLC classes on October 16th to help students get signed up.
