## 2SLGBTQ+ ADMINISTRATIVE COMMITTEE

The Superintendent has made the decision to form a 2SLGBTQ+ Administrative Committee. The intent is to provide a venue where information sharing and dialogue can occur regarding initiatives and supports for the 2SLGBTQ+ community in the District.

The name 2SLGBTQ+ reflects the inclusion of the term two-spirited, which is an addition made in January 2023 after consultation with our Aboriginal Education Advisory Board.

## Terms of Reference

- 1. To provide an avenue for partner groups to give input and suggestions to the District with respect to initiatives, supports, and emerging issues pertaining to the 2SLGBTQ+ community.
- 2. Review 2SLGBTQ+ educational programs and services for students, staff and parents, and make recommendations to the Superintendent.
- To provide input regarding changes to <u>Administrative Procedure 170</u>: Anti-Harassment and <u>Anti-Discrimination</u>, <u>Administrative Procedure 409</u>: <u>Workplace Discrimination Bullying and Harassment</u>, <u>Administrative Procedure 350</u>: <u>Student Code of Conduct</u>, and make recommendations to the Superintendent with respect to the implementation of these administrative procedures.
- 4. Consider strategies that support the 2SLGBTQ+ community, as outlined in the LGBTQ+ Report to the Board, June 18, 2013 and make recommendations to the Superintendent.
- 5. The committee will consist of a Trustee from the Board of Education, an Assistant Superintendent, the District Administrator of Student Support Services, 2 LTA Representatives, a CUPE 1260 Representative, a CUPE 1851 Representative, an LPVPA Representative, a DPAC Representative, a Representative from the Aboriginal Community, a Representative from the District Excluded Staff, a school Counsellor and several Student Representatives. Representatives from community groups and agencies will be invited as necessary.
- 6. The minutes of the committee will be published and shared with the Superintendent.

7. The Committee will be chaired by the District Administrator, Student Support Services and/or the Assistant Superintendent.
