LITERACY & NUMERACY

To implement targeted strategies and interventions that enhance **reading literacy** and comprehension skills across Grades 1-7, ensuring measurable growth in student reading achievement through differentiated instruction, ongoing assessment, and inclusive literacy practices.

To improve students' confidence and ability in **numeracy** by focusing on number sense, mental math strategies, and real-world problem-solving across all grade levels.



SOCIAL EMOTIONAL LEARNING & CAREER EDUCATION

To improve student behaviour and **emotional regulation** by implementing consistent, school-wide strategies including mindfulness practices, empathy-building activities, and regulation tools, supported by common language and modelling used by all staff.

Students will develop an understanding of their strengths, interests, and values, and begin to explore how these connect to future learning opportunities, community roles, and **career pathways**.
