UNIFIED ACTIONS:

SCHOOL WIDE DATA-INFORMED PRACTICE

- Collecting and analyzing literacy and numeracy data (DIBELS, classroom assessments, numeracy screeners) to guide instruction and interventions.
- Using data cycles in PLCs to set goals, track progress, and adjust strategies.

PROFESSIONAL LEARNING COMMUNITIES (PLC)

- Embedding structured collaboration time for staff to focus on literacy, numeracy, and social-emotional priorities.
- Sharing best practices, examining student work, and co-developing strategies across grade levels and subject areas.

ADVISORY & SEL PROGRAMS

- Implementing Open Parachute as a school wide SEL program to foster resilience, empathy, and mental health awareness.
- Embedding Advisory as a common structure for connection, reflection, and wellness conversations.

RESTORATIVE AND INCLUSIVE PRACTICES

- Utilizing restorative approaches school wide to strengthen relationships and resolve conflicts.
- Providing safe and inclusive spaces (e.g., The Nest) to support complex learners and build belonging.
