Dear Parents:

We have planned the Ski and Snowboard Program for Yorkson Creek this year to <u>Cypress Mountain Resort</u> on <u>Wednesday, February 5th, 12th, 19th and 26th, 2025.</u> We have reserved 144 spots at Cypress Mountain ski school for interested students.

During this program, students will be learning how to ski or snowboard and will be involved in skiing or snowboarding lessons and free skiing or snowboarding time. This trip is related to the Physical Health Education curriculum in the following ways: Exploration of life long physical activities.

Skiing and snowboarding are inherently risky activities with falls and spills expected. It is very demanding physically, especially for students new to these sports. Students of similar abilities are grouped for the lessons; however, students may ski with friends of various abilities during the free time after the lesson. It should be noted that during some of the free ski time it will be dark, with students restricted to only the runs that are lit. Students are never permitted to ski or snowboard alone.

We will be travelling to Cypress Mountain and back to Yorkson Creek Middle by bus. We will depart from the school Wednesday, February 5th, 12th, 19th and 26th, 2025 at 11:20am and return to the school on the same day at 7:45pm. You will need to arrange to have your child picked-up promptly at 7:45pm. Students are not permitted to walk home upon return to the school. Staff members along with parent chaperones will be supervising on the bus and on the mountain.

The costs for skiing or snowboarding this year are listed below. Please note that anyone 1 part in this program MUST take all four lessons.

Student Prices and Payment (via School Cash Online):

- Full Package (bus transportation, lessons, lifts, and rentals): \$425
- Bus transportation, lift tickets and lessons (no-rental): \$340
- Bus transportation, rentals and lessons (season pass holder): \$370
- Bus transportation, lessons only (season pass holder, no-rental): \$285

Payment must be made online only. Please pay online and select the correct package when paying. Attach your receipt to your signed waiver and consent form showing proof of payment.

Food: Cypress is a <u>cashless</u> mountain. Students will either need to bring their own bagged dinner or bring a debit or credit card. Students have the option to purchase a Cypress gift card at guest services with cash.

Lottery System:

We have 144 reserved spots at Cypress Mountain and often the number of applicants exceeds this amount. As such, there will be a lottery system to determine participants in the program. Students will have until Friday, November 1st to submit their completed online application as well as the signed paper copies of the School District #35 waiver and consent forms. All applications will be reviewed and applications that are completed, with payment receipt attached, will be entered into a lottery for a spot. Students will be notified by November 7th as to whether they received a spot. We will keep a waitlist. There are no refunds for students who are selected, no exceptions!

Permission forms should be given directly to Mrs. Parkes in room E208. Applications turned into the front office will NOT be accepted. Applications are only considered complete when online applications are complete and waiver and consent forms with payment receipt are submitted together. If your child receives a spot in this program, payments for this field trip are nonrefundable. Students who miss a day will receive a lift ticket voucher.

Notices with payment are due by Friday, November 1st, 2024.


My child and I understand that the school's Code of Conduct and the Alpine Responsibility Code applies during this trip.
