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Values and Expectations

Members of the Rugby Academy are members of the DW Poppy Redhawks Rugby Program. The Academy and the Rugby Program are founded on ten core values that guide the actions, choices, and behaviours of the members. As a Rugby Academy/ Program member you are expected to play, study, and live in accordance with these core values, which are known as PRIDE and FAITH: Passion, Respect, Integrity, Discipline, and Effort; Family, Accountability, Intent, Tenacity, and Humility.

Additional Information

- Completion of this form in full is required. A follow-up interview may be required, particularly for transfer students.
- This academy is a year-long commitment, with two courses in the timetable during the first semester and one course outside the timetable (after school) in the second semester.
- There is a \$600 cost per year for students to enroll in the Rugby Academy, covering kit, ref/coach certification fees, equipment, etc.. This fee does not include any potential travel costs; these costs would be extra.
- Applicable BC School Sports Regulations:
 - Any applicant who is accepted and transfers from another school while in Grade 9 or beyond will lose a year of eligibility if they have played rugby for their school in the season prior to the transfer (with some rare exceptions). While such an applicant will be able to take full advantage of the Academy, they will likely not be eligible to play for DW Poppy's rugby teams in the year of their transfer.
 - Students who reside out-of-catchment may not both receive sport specific instruction greater than 4 credits per year and participate for the school team in that sport.
- The Academy is divided into two cohorts: **Junior Academy** for students in Grades 9 and 10, and **Senior Academy** for students in Grades 11 and 12. Each year of the academy comprises 3 courses (including PHE credits for each year a student is enrolled). A student enrolled in all four years of the Rugby Academy would receive a total of 48 credits.
