***Performance Pass:**

Throughout the year, our students attend numerous in-house arts performances put on by classes, majors or pods. These performances take place in the Chief Sepass Theatre and are often matinee runs of the various shows produced each year. This money is used to offset costs associated with the performance and using the Chief Sepass Theatre. Instead of a small ticket price being charged several times throughout the year, we request that all students (Gr. K-12) pay for a yearly LFAS Performance Pass at a cost of \$20.00. Teachers will ensure that students participate in several in-house performance-based field trips per year.
