
Re: Langley Secondary School Community Consultation

On February 17, 2015, the Langley Board of Education approved submitting to the Ministry of Education, a business case requesting a partial replacement of Langley Secondary School.

This recommendation was a result of the recent consultation process in which your school community participated. The LSS family of schools were represented by passionate advocates for your schools and children; the School District and Board of Education sincerely appreciates your involvement and commitment.

The District will now submit a business case to the Ministry of Education and await a response. Once this information is available it will be communicated to schools. In the interim, the District will meet with the community to prepare initial plans and to address questions arising from the community. At this time, no timeline is known as to when the District will hear back from the Ministry of Education.

As the District moves forward, Mr. Gord Stewart, Assistant Superintendent of Schools, will be facilitating this process.
