

This play explores themes of justice and humanity, fate versus free will, and the consequences of absolute power. Antigone remains a timeless and deeply pertinent story for modern audiences.



Contact Mrs. Faber and let her know you'd like to be considered for assistance. Once applications are reviewed you will be contacted with further details.






