### **Career News:**

We had a great trip this past Monday to the Mary Gordon Health Centre at Douglas College. Students got to learn about the various adaptive tools used in Therapeutic Recreation and the work they do in the community. We also got to learn more about the Nursing program. We had three stations led by practicing nurses and instructors where students got to observe a simulation scenario in the lab, practice their CPR skills on infants and adults, as well as listen/identify normal and abnormal heart beats.

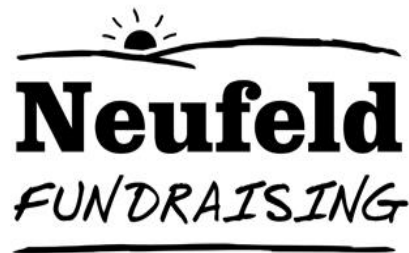

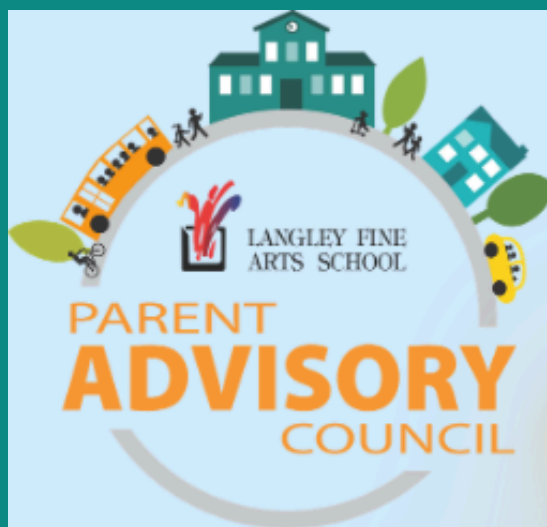
