



INFORMATION ABOUT SCHOOL STATUS DURING INCLEMENT WEATHER

Snow closures and power outages are an annual occurrence in Langley School District. So, where do you go to get information about the status of schools during periods of inclement weather? If you are able to access the internet via computer or smartphone, current information about Langley schools can be accessed on all school websites or www.sd35.bc.ca. Updates are also posted to X (formerly Twitter) @LangleySchools and Facebook at www.facebook.com/langleyschooldistrict. If you don't have internet connectivity but your phone is working, call a relative or friend in an area that has not been affected by the storm and ask them to check the district website for you. Local radio stations are also informed of school status in Langley. Tune in to CKWX 1130AM, CKNW 980AM, Country Radio 107.1FM, Pulse 107.7 or CBC 690AM or 88.1FM for updates.

Please note that Langley District schools are all considered 'open' until a decision to close is required. Decisions on school closures are usually made by 6:30am. As always, it is a parent's decision whether to send their child to school based on safety and individual circumstances. If you feel it is unsafe for you or your child to travel to or attend an open school for any reason, please keep your child home and report an absence to the school.



WEATHER APPROPRIATE CLOTHING

Now that the colder and wetter weather is upon us, we are asking parents to ensure that their children are appropriately dressed for school and outside playtime. Boots and warm, waterproof jackets are especially important as we send our students outside for fresh air, even during wet weather.



LOST AND FOUND

Our lost and found bins are overflowing. Please ask your child to check and claim what may belong to them.

Parents/caregivers are welcome to check the bins as well; however, this can only be done before or after school.

YEARBOOK CONSENT FORMS

Last week, students in Kindergarten to Grade 8 were handed <u>Yearbook Consent Forms</u> which were to be brought home, signed by a parent (if you give consent) and returned to the classroom teacher. Please check your child's backpack or ask them if they received this form. It is very important that we receive this form back as it provides consent for your child to be published in the annual LFAS yearbook. Without consent, they will not have their image or name printed.

If your child is going to be absent, arriving late, away or leaving early due to an appointment, please notify the school of your child's absence by email or call the school. To report an absence by email, send information including student first name and last name, grade, division, length of absence, and reason to LFAAttendance@sd35.bc.ca.

To report an absence by phone, call 604-888-3113 and follow the prompts for the attendance line to leave a message with information including student first name and last name, grade, division, length of absence, and reason.

VOLUNTEERS AND PARENT DRIVERS AT LFAS – UPDATED PROCESSES


Come join us for a rejuvenating experience and help support LFAS Dry Grad. Let the soothing sounds wash over you as you relax and unwind.


Do you have new or gently used items you are looking to rehome? We could use them!
