OFFICE PROCEDURES

Office hours are 8:15 a.m. to 3:30 pm. We ask parents to help reduce the volume of phone calls to the office by following these guidelines:

PLEASE CALL OR EMAIL BEFORE 9:30AM IF YOUR CHILD WILL BE ABSENT OR LATE

If your child is going to be absent, arriving late, away or leaving early due to an appointment, please notify the school of your child's absence by email or call the school. To report an absence by email, send information including student first name and last name, grade, division, length of absence, and reason to LFAAttendance@sd35.bc.ca.

To report an absence by phone, call 604-888-3113 and follow the prompts for the attendance line to leave a message with information including student first name and last name, grade, division, length of absence, and reason.

PARENT CONSENTS

This year, we will be collecting parent consents through an online form rather than on paper. At the beginning of the school year, an email with instructions, will be sent to the primary guardian of each child as indicated in MyEdBC.

<u>These forms are separate</u> from the verification forms and reunification forms which are being sent home on paper to each student.

VOLUNTEER DRIVER FORMS

There are usually a few field trips throughout the school year. For some of these, our teachers rely on Parent volunteer drivers. In order to drive for a field trip, parents are required to fill out our volunteer driver form and provide copies of their driver's license, ICBC insurance, private insurance (if applicable) and an ICBC Driver's abstract. To avoid delay in the approval, process this information can be scanned and emailed to Mrs. Gill at kgill@sd35.bc.ca. This can be done at any time during the year; you don't have to wait until the date of the field trip, which usually causes panic and a last-minute line up of parents trying to fill out forms.

Please remember that this process needs to be done for <u>each new school year</u>.

STUDENT INFORMATION VERIFICATION FORMS

Students will be handed a **BLUE** student verification form in their class. This form is the contact and medical information we have in our system about our students. Please make any corrections in red ink (if possible). Please return the form by September 19th as it is required for safety reasons and to update the Parent Portal System (this system allows parents access to student information including report cards).

ABORIGINAL SELF IDENTIFICATION FORMS

The Aboriginal Self Identification forms were sent electronically with the Parent Letter in August as well as a paper copy with the student verification forms. This is very <u>TIME SENSITIVE</u>, and the forms are required by <u>Friday</u>, <u>September 12th</u> if you are self-identifying.

PARKING LOT – PICK UP/DROP OFF SAFETY

As many of you have experienced first-hand, things are very busy during morning drop off and afternoon pick up times. We need to work together to ensure everyone's safety during morning drop off and afternoon pick up. This applies to both the front and back of the school.

The curb lane is for pick up and drop off ONLY.

The inside lane is for driving through so please do not stop while in this lane.

Do not leave your car unattended in these areas. It causes a lot of traffic issues for the other parents/caregivers that are trying to also pick up and drop off their children.

If you need to leave your vehicle to either drop off or pick up your children or to enter the school, please park your car.

Please let anyone that you allow to pick up or drop off your children, aware of this as they may not be aware of this email.

The parking lot near the Chief Sepass Door entrances has lots of room – please consider dropping older students here. Thank you for your cooperation in keeping out students safe!
