Substance Use Decriminalization Information for Parents, Guardians and Caregivers

The Ministry of Mental Health and Addictions, in partnership with the Ministry of Education and Child Care, has developed an information sheet on substance use decriminalization for parents, guardians, and caregivers. Talking to Children and Youth about Decriminalization and Substance Use: Resources for Parents/Guardians and Caregivers is now available on the erase website.

Beedie Scholarships are excited to announce that they are expanding the eligibility criteria for **SPARK (Single Parent Award for Resilient and Knowledge)** scholarships for single parents by removing the requirement that parents be referred by a partner organization. They look forward to granting up to 15 scholarships this year worth up to \$44,000 each to single parents facing financial adversity in BC.

"Single parents, regardless of their situation, face many barriers when trying to further their education, whether it is paying for tuition, finding childcare or balancing work and school with raising a family," says Ryan Beedie. "That is why we are opening up eligibility to the SPARK Program to all single parents across BC. This will give more parents across the province the opportunity to upgrade their education and make life better for themselves and their families."
