What is the Elmer Helm Youth Fund?

All participants receive a certificate, with chances to earn **Gold, Silver, or Bronze** awards.

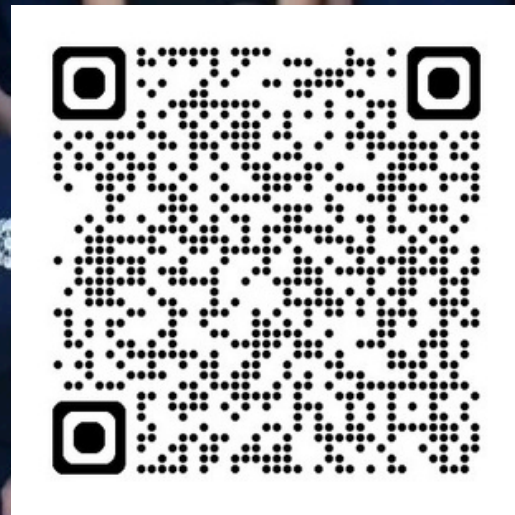
