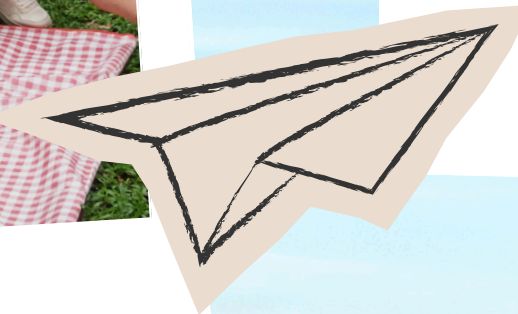

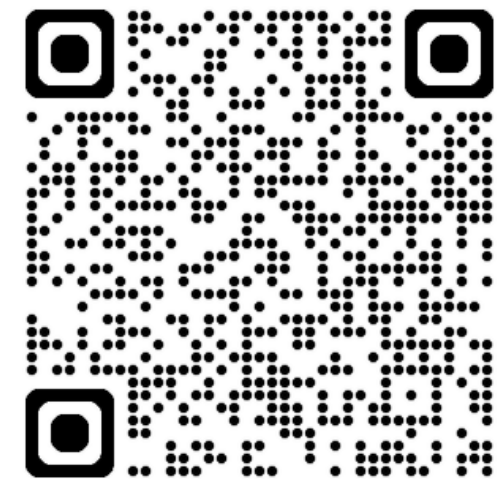
Overview

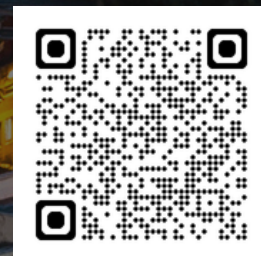
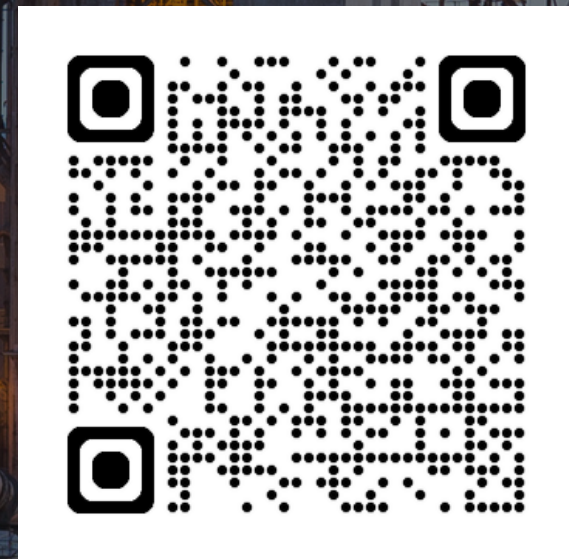
To be eligible for the Horatio Alger British Columbia VTE Scholarships, applicants must:

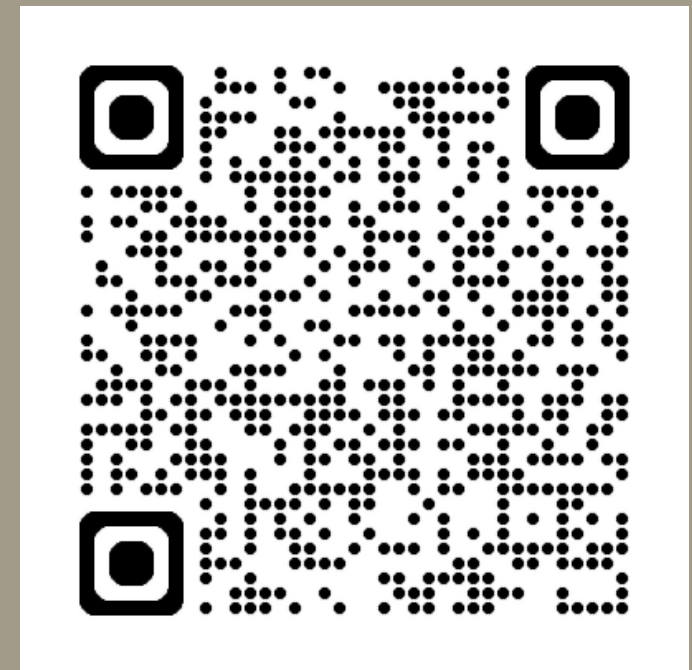

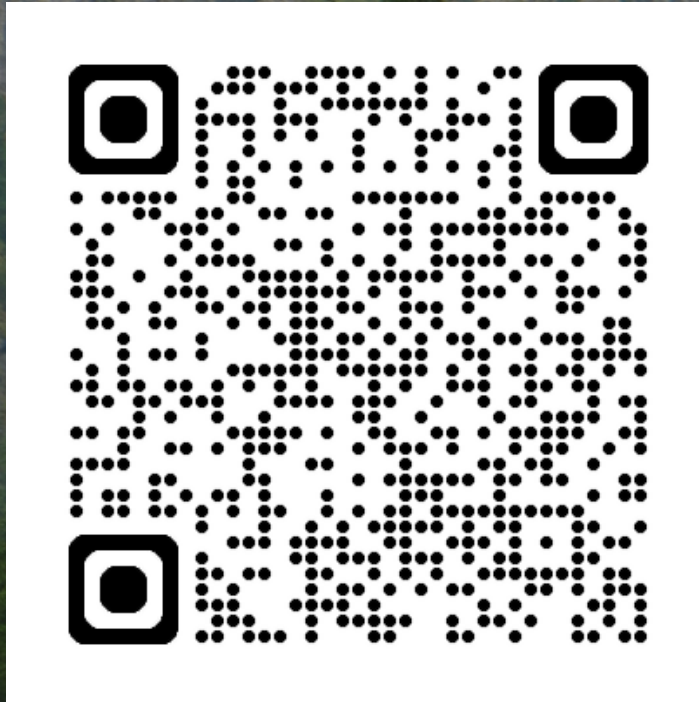

Part of COFI's mission is to support students pursuing post-secondary education or training in a skilled trades program associated with the forest industry.

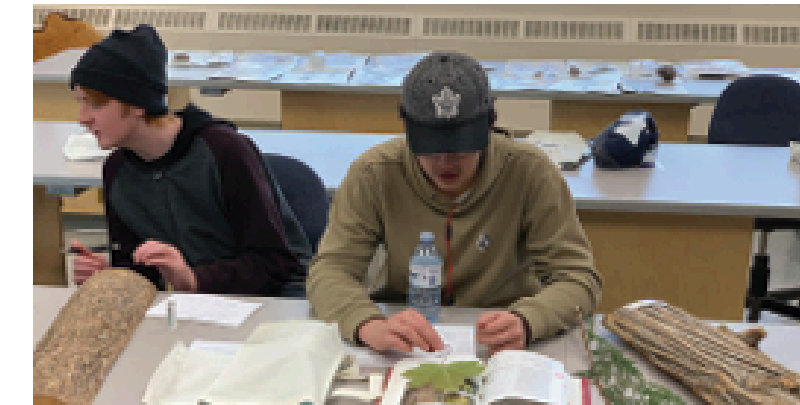
