What is the Elmer Helm Youth Fund?

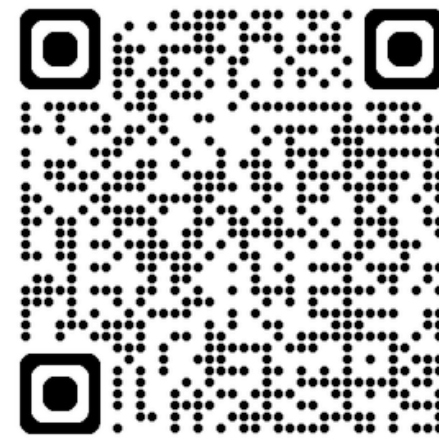

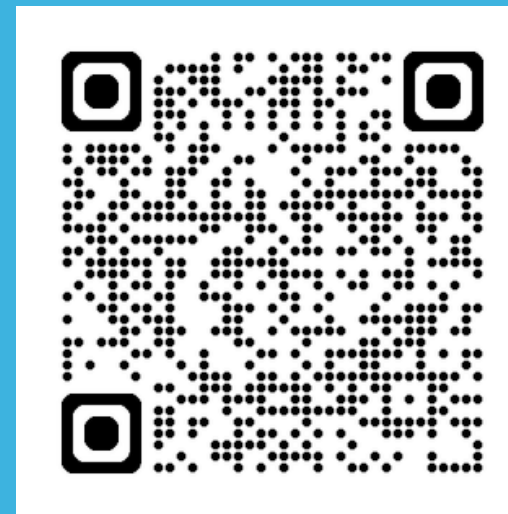

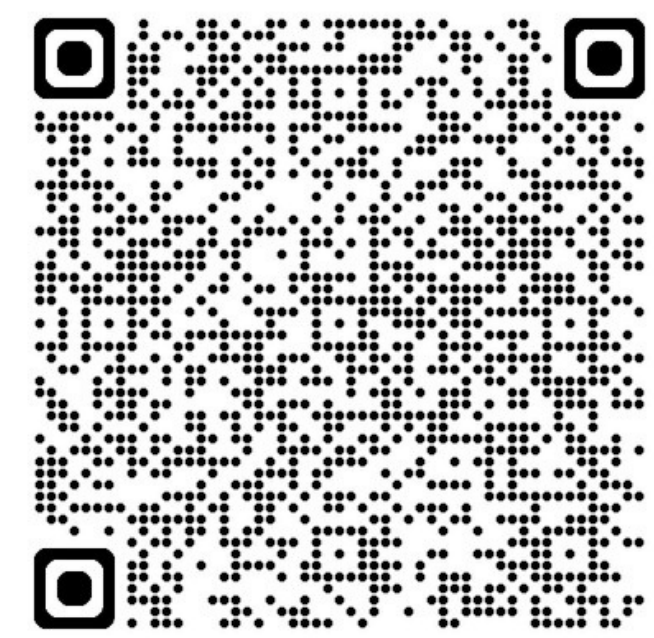

Health Career Access Program (HCAP)

The **Health Career Access Program (HCAP)** is a fully funded route for applicants with little to no health care experience to enter the health care sector.

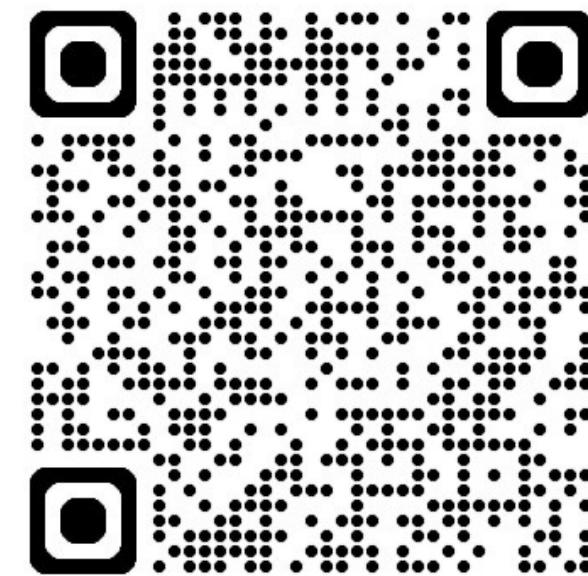
