Application Process for Programs of Choice for 2025-2026 – Kindergarten

If you wish your child to enter Kindergarten at Coghlan in September 2025 you must follow an application process! Siblings get priority over outside applicants providing they have a Langley/Aldergrove Address. If you do not make the application within the deadlines your sibling child will not get a space.

For entry into the 2025-2026 school year, registration begins Monday, October 7th, 2024 at 12 noon, and closes Monday, October 21st, 2024 at 12 noon.

Parking Lot – Drop Off Zone

A friendly reminder when dropping off/picking up your child(ren) before/after school, please ensure you pull over to the very front of the drop off zone lane. Langley School District offers a rich diversity of programs that are designed to meet the specific needs and interests of students. Registration for Kindergarten entry (for most programs) begins on **Monday, October 7th at 12 noon**, and closes on **Monday, October 21st at 12 noon**. <u>U-Connect – Kindergarten to Grade 3 Spaces Available: Elementary</u>

Is your child in need of an education program that offers more flexibility and continues to meet their educational needs? U-Connect may be a great fit for your child. The blended learning program has students in class two days a week with an optional third day offered for additional student support and fun community field trips. Students will be at home two to three days per week, which enables them to discover their own extra-curricular passions and allows for caregivers to support students at home in partnership with school. Students will build on their own personal learning style with the support of caring and dedicated teachers. Interested students and their families are encouraged to call the school to get more information or learn more here.

When and how long to keep sick kids home from school

When to keep kids home from school in BC?

Please keep your child home if they: Have a fever. Are too sick to take part in all normal school activities. Have a suspected or known communicable disease (i.e. strep throat, chicken pox, measles).

How long after sickness can you go back to school?

Children with diarrhoea or vomiting should stay away from school until they have not been sick or had diarrhoea for at least 2 days (48 hours).

How long are kids contagious with a cold?

Colds are the most common infectious disease. They're very contagious, especially in the first 2–4 days after symptoms start. They can even spread for a couple of weeks after someone starts feeling sick.

How long after flu can you return to school?

Children with the flu should be isolated in the home, away from other people. They should also stay home until they have no fever without the use of fever-control medicines and they feel well for 24 hours. Remind your child to protect others by covering his or her mouth when coughing or sneezing.

Why do you have to wait 24 hours after a fever?

Within 24 hours of a fever, your child's immune system is weakened, and they are much more likely to catch something else. This is why it can seem like your child is better for a couple of days, only to be sick again





SCHOOL PICTURE ORDERING ALL ONLINE!

Your child will have brought home a printed proof. It is blue!

Ensure you check their bag, school planner, or with their classroom teacher if you have not received it.

On the proof is an access key in the top right corner, you will enter this access code at:

Make sure you have accessed your photo gallery, either to place your photo order orto request retakes!

Once the order due date is past, having the photo order returned back to the school will not be possible. The only shipping option available after the due date is our \$10 'Ship to Provided Adress' option, that will have your order mailed to the address provided at checkout.



RETAKES - NOVEMBER S

Darby Photos has a new retake session procedure, designed to ensure every student who needs a portrait on retake day gets one.

Students can only attend a retake session for one of two reasons:

- They missed the main picture day, and did not get portraits taken
- The request for a retake is made by the students family through their online gallery

Darby Photos system produces a list of students that did not get portraits completed on the original photo day, so if your child does not attend the main day then they will be called down on retake day automatically. There is no need to notify your school or Darby Photos.

If your child attended the main photo day but you wish to have retakes done, the request must be made through their online gallery prior to the due date listed on your proof. You will have received a physical printed proof that your child brought home from school recently explaining how to view the gallery and make this request. Our system then compiles a list of all of these requests. If you dont have the proof, check your childs bag, and then with the classroom teacher.

Only students that are on our list will be invited down during the retake session to streamline the experience. You will not be able to add your child to the list by contacting your school or Darby Photos, the only way to have them added is through the online gallery retake request function.

Please note that if your child attends the retake session, any original images that were taken on the main photo day will nolonger be accessible.
