Application Process for Programs of Choice for 2025-2026 – Kindergarten

If you wish your child to enter Kindergarten at Coghlan in September 2025 you must follow an application process! Siblings get priority over outside applicants providing they have a Langley/Aldergrove Address. If you do not make the application within the deadlines your sibling child will not get a space.

For entry into the 2025-2026 school year, registration begins Monday, October 7th, 2024 at 12 noon, and closes Monday, October 21st, 2024 at 12 noon.

Election Day – Use of School Sites

On Saturday October 19th many of our school gyms across the District will be used as provincial election polling stations from 8am – 8pm. As guided by Section 81 of the Election Act "accommodation in a school that is the property of a board of school trustees under the School Act must be made available by the board for use as a voting place." Please take note of extra pedestrian and vehicle traffic in the area of these sites on election day.

The District appreciates the support and cooperation from families and members of our community. The District is encouraging everyone who is eligible to do their civic duty and vote. For a list of school sites being used, visit the District website here.

Programs of Choice - Deadline to Register is Monday. October 21st

Langley School District offers a rich diversity of programs that are designed to meet the specific needs and interests of students. Registration for Kindergarten entry (for most programs) begins on **Monday, October 7th at 12 noon**, and closes on **Monday, October 21st at 12 noon**. When and how long to keep sick kids home from school

When to keep kids home from school in BC?

Please keep your child home if they: Have a fever. **Are too sick to take part in all normal school activities.** Have a suspected or known communicable disease (i.e. strep throat, chicken pox, measles).

How long after sickness can you go back to school?

Children with diarrhoea or vomiting should stay away from school until they have not been sick or had diarrhoea for at least 2 days (48 hours).

How long are kids contagious with a cold?

Colds are the most common infectious disease. They're very contagious, especially in the first 2–4 days after symptoms start. They can even spread for a couple of weeks after someone starts feeling sick.

How long after flu can you return to school?

Children with the flu should be isolated in the home, away from other people. They should also stay home until they have no fever without the use of fever-control medicines and they feel well for 24 hours. Remind your child to protect others by covering his or her mouth when coughing or sneezing.

Why do you have to wait 24 hours after a fever?

Within 24 hours of a fever, your child's immune system is weakened, and they are much more likely to catch something else. This is why it can seem like your child is better for a couple of days, only to be sick again

Dear Parents and Caregivers,

A new Hot Lunch Program has coming to our school. The Program is being funded by the Province of British Columbia through the Feeding Futures Fund. The goal is to make wholesome meals more accessible for our students. Please note this program is in addition to our Coghlan PAC Munch A Lunch (where the funds benefit our school).

We will be working together with the Lunch Lady to deliver this new program at Coghlan.

Meal service is available every **Tuesday**. **Each meal is individually labeled and packaged and affordably priced at \$6.75**. **Regular, vegetarian and halal friendly options are always available. New menus are posted monthly.**

For **Tuesday** lunch delivery, please place your order by **Thursday 10 pm** (the week prior to delivery). We recommend ordering for a month at a time but the program is flexible and you can join this pilot Lunch Program at any time.

Setting Up a Regular Account – Please use this one-time registration link **order.lunchlady.ca/signup/54** To register for your lunch account. Once an account is created, place your order, and pay for your child's hot lunches at **order.lunchlady.ca**

Requesting a Subsidized Account - This program is for everyone. If your family is experiencing food insecurity or financial hardship, fully subsidized lunches are also available. Please reach out to your school office or trusted adult in the school for your one-time registration link. (*We promise to respect your privacy. Subsidy information will only be shared with school staff such as the Principal, school secretary, and The Lunch Lady as required*). All meals will look the same when delivered and no one will know the subsidy status of any child. Children are asked to **bring a leak-proof bag** to school on hot lunch days as all leftovers and containers can be taken home. Students are also encouraged to bring their own re-usable cutlery from home each lunch day.
