Principal's Report (J. Harris)

- Building Projects completed/underway/coming to Poppy:
 - o Field improvements improvements made
 - Front of school renovations Phase 1 is complete new paving, addition of a speed hump making
 the front of the school wheelchair accessible (automatic door opener button being installed
 shortly for the front doors allowing better accessibility to the school); Phases 2 & 3 are getting
 underway upgrades include completely redoing the landscaping by the old flagpoles (which are
 being moved) and increased seating areas.
 - New flooring on the main floor to be installed over the summer
 - Painting of the interior over the next year/year and half
 - New student made benches were installed throughout the school (~18-22 of them)
 - Locker upgrades coming painting, replacing, etc.
 - Cafeteria upgrades will be completed by next school year, improving the seating and usability of the cafeteria greatly (no more 80's cafeteria tables!)
