Centres around collaborative work that gathers data about the students and what they need to further their learning. From the data learning interventions are created, implemented, tracked for efficacy and updates made if needed.

What can be done to address this?

- Response – this ties back to the PLC's as the math PLC is going back to the feeder schools to discuss their expectations of students in grade 8 and to better learn the expectations of what the feeder school's teachers are as well (in terms of what their curriculum is, etc.)
