First Week Of School

Tuesday, September 2nd - **Grade 6 students ONLY**

Time - 8:45am -11:30am

Sign-in (alphabetical) begins at the front of the school at 8:30am. Once students have received a name tag they will wait outside until 8:45am and the WEB leaders will guide them into the gym.

We will have many staff members available to support students and help to ensure they know where to go. Students will be connecting with our grade 8 WEB leaders and will be given a snack and juice box. At the end of the orientation, students will have the opportunity to connect with their homeroom teacher and will be given instructions in preparation for their full day on Wednesday, September 3rd. Please leave all school supplies at home as students will not need them for their orientation day.







Wednesday, September 3rd – ALL grades 6-8 students

First FULL day - 8:45am-2:55pm

On Tuesday, Sept 2nd by 5PM an email will be sent by homeroom teachers confirming grade 7 & 8 students' division number, teacher name and room location. I have attached a school map to help guide you. Please watch for this email and check your junk mail if you do not receive it.

If you do not receive an email and your child does not know what class to attend then please have them ask a staff member who will be able to guide them. Students who are new and have not registered should report to the office.







How do I find my classroom on the first day of school?

Grade 6 students will enter through the front doors on Tues. September 2nd

During their morning orientation, they will learn where their homeroom is. The following day, Grade 6's will line up at their homeroom exterior door.



On Wed. Sept. 3rd

Grade 7 students will return to their former Grade 6 homeroom.

On Tuesday September 2^{nd} , all Grade 7 & 8 families will receive an email with a school map attached explaining which homeroom their child will go to on Wednesday September 3^{rd}

Any student who is unsure of where there classroom is, can meet staff at the front doors of the school and they will be helped.


