



Langley Fundamental Middle and Secondary School Study Block Application 2026-2027



Langley Fundamental Middle and Secondary School offers a rich variety of courses and believes that students should take advantage of the opportunity for a full-time education. In-school study blocks are a privilege reserved for senior students who have ample credits and challenging course loads.

Grade 12 Students

Grade 12 students are permitted a semester **OR** a linear Study Block. This is dependent on a student's course load and schedule.

A maximum of one study block in the school year is permitted and a Grade 12 student must enroll in eight courses.

- ✓ The student must have excellent attendance and work habits.
- ✓ The student must have completed a minimum of 68 credits by the end of their Grade 11 year.
- ✓ The student must be taking a minimum of four academically rigorous courses (electives courses are not considered rigorous).
- ✓ If a student decides to take an online course (but it can be scheduled on-site), then they are not eligible for a Study block.

*(Note: A student who is carrying fewer than 6 courses at LFMS will be **INELIGIBLE** for many school-based scholarships and awards.)*

Grade 11 Students

Grade 11 students are required to enroll in EIGHT courses. Students who have successfully completed 40 credits by the end of their Grade 10 year **AND** have no Grade 10 courses on their Grade 11 schedule may apply for a Study Block if one of the following criteria are met:

- ✓ The student is enrolled in an extended day course (*i.e. Choir, Band, Musical Theatre*)
- ✓ The student maintains a rigorous academic load, a minimum of six or more academics, and would benefit from a Study Block (*permission from parents and administration required*).

Grade 8, 9, and 10 Students do not qualify for a Study Block.

EXPECTATIONS OF STUDY BLOCKS

- Students are expected to report to the Library Learning Commons for Study Block.
- Students are not to be in the hallways or outside the building on the property.
- Students are expected to work productively in Study Block.
- Students are allowed off of the school property with parent permission. (*see parent signature below*)
- Students must report to the Office Staff in the evacuation area during an emergency evacuation

Important: LFMS Admin has the right to have a Study Block rescinded and replaced with an enrolling course if expectations are not met.
