- Signature of Natural Parent, Homestay & School Coordinator
- ☐ If flying, the Student's Plane Ticket (should be purchased after getting trip approval from ISP Department)
- □ If flying alone for part of the trip, a letter from Natural Parents stating that the student can travel alone from YVR to relative/close family friend
- Proof of additional insurance (students on MSP, if travelling out of BC)
- For high-risk activity, a company waiver signed by the natural parent
- □ I have checked the expiration dates of all relevant travel documents listed below. The documents do not expire in the 3 months prior to my return date.

The student must take the following on the trip:

- BC Medical Card
- Study Insured Card (valid in Canada & US)
