





What

Work And Volunteer Experience (WAVE) is a four-credit Grade 12 elective course focusing on career exploration. Students will complete assignments to prepare them to work, volunteer and/or job shadow for 80-170 hours at an employer's place(s) of business.

Why

- Complete course credits outside of a school in an area of interest
- Start with a new employer or continue where you are already working/volunteering
- Acquire skills and experience employers want
- Get a head start on your career
- Have a smoother transition from school to work
- Potential to be offered paid employment with employers
- Take more than nine courses in a school year, does not impact current school schedule
- Find your own employer or connect with the assistance of a teacher
- Earn up to eight elective credits towards graduation (equals two courses)
- Get paid or gain volunteer experience while earning school graduation credits
- Gain experience in almost any industry/occupation

When

- Complete work after school, weekends, and holidays, including winter, spring and summer break
- Best to register during course selection
- Can sign up during the school year

Who

- Be in grade 10-12
- Have parent/guardian permission (if under 19)
- Complete school requirements to participate in a placement
- Arrange your own transportation to/from the employer
- Work/volunteer up to 170 hours with an employer
- Follow expectations from SD35, your school and your employer

Where

- There are two parts to this course. What you do for school and what you do for the employer.
 - Schoolwork will be done with your
 WAVE teacher in school or online
 - Placement will be at the employer's their place(s) of business



Key Learning Outcomes	 Apply job search and interview skills. Identify transferrable skills specific to the work placement. Develop a plan to address skill development and refinement. Access information and ideas on workplace safety prior to work placement to determine workplace safety risks. Identify, demonstrate and incorporate provincially legislated safety and site-specific worksite safety procedures while at the work placement.

	 Document work experience to demonstrate required hours. Engage in ongoing reflection and documentation of work experience as it relates to current and future pathways. Reflect on independent and collaborative problem-solving strategies implemented, specific to the work placement.
