Attendance on Tuesday, September 2

Grade 9 students and new students (Gr. 10-12) will be invited to attend school on Tuesday, September 2. Grade 10-12 students who have previously been at R.E. Mountain will join us on Wednesday, September 3.

- All Grade 9 students will receive an invitation next week to attend our Grade 9 orientation that will be held on September 2nd. Students will attend either a morning or afternoon orientation session. These first days of School Activities are extremely important to ensure our Grade 9's have an excellent start to their year.
- Grade 9 students will also have their school photo taken on this day (Tuesday, September 2).
- Grade 10-12 students who are new to REMSS will be invited to an orientation from 10am to 12pm on Tuesday, September 2. More information about this opportunity will be sent out to our new students and we highly recommend students attend.

BELL SCHEDULE 2025-2026

Over the past few years, we have seen a great deal of growth and development in our community. While there are plans for a new Secondary school in the Willoughby area in the future, and plans for a future expansion of REMSS, there are continued pressures around enrollment in our area. Our bell schedule has been adjusted to ensure that students will continue to have access to as many course opportunities as possible.

We took feedback on our bell schedule last year and shifted the block times to make reading the schedule easier and to enable us to provide even more classroom spaces for students. This schedule is a subtle shift from our previous one and offers the following:

- A set schedule for each day of the week.
- Continued inclusion of flex time each day.
- Keeping the dismissal time no later than 3:15pm and adjusting the block times for easier viewing.
- More early morning linear classes for grade 11 and 12 students to ensure greater access to class options.
- Reduced traffic issues around pick up and drop off times.

Students in grades 9 and 10, and any students in complex resource, will all start at 9:10am and end at 3:15pm, unless they are taking music or high-performance classes. Students in grades 11 and 12 will be scheduled between 8:00am and 3:15pm to ensure they have full access to all our course opportunities.

This is the bell schedule for the 2025-26 school year. Scheduled 8:00am classes are year long on either Day 1 (Mon, Thurs, and alternating Wed) or Day 2 (Tue, Fri, and alternating Wed).

We highly recommend students and parents download the MySchoolDay App which details information about each day's block order and includes the option of notifications about important events.

SAFE ARRIVAL APP

R.E. Mountain Secondary utilizes an automated attendance management system called SafeArrival, offered through School Messenger, the system that hosts our parent notification system. Accessible at: <https://go.schoolmessenger.ca>

With SafeArrival, you are asked to report your child's absence in advance using any of these 3 convenient methods:

1. SchoolMessenger App - Using your mobile device, download and install the SchoolMessenger app from the Apple App Store or the Google Play Store. The first time you use the app, select Sign Up to create your account. Select Attendance then Report an Absence.
2. SafeArrival Website - Use the SafeArrival website, <https://go.schoolmessenger.ca>. The first time you use the website, select Sign Up to create your account. Select Attendance then Report an Absence.

3. Toll-Free Phone - Call the toll-free number 1-833-294-4837 to report an absence using the automated phone system.

When signing up for an account, you must sign up using the parent / guardian e-mail that is on file with the school. If you are calling the toll-free number, you must call from the parent / guardian phone number on file with the school. These options are available 24 hours/day, 7 days a week. We ask that daily absences are reported before 3 p.m. on the day of the absence, this includes late arrivals and early departures. Future absences can be reported at any time. If absences are not reported before the cut-off time, the parent / guardian may still receive an automatic notification in the evening to inform of an absence. Absences are only to be reported by parents / guardians on file with the school. Students are not to report their own absences.

We are a very large school with a high volume of calls. Please use the 3 options above to report absences as the school office will not be able to accept calls regarding attendance. Parents / guardians will need to report via the app, website, or toll-free number in a timely manner.

If you have children attending other schools, please continue to report absences using the existing procedures for those schools. If you plan to be away for the first few days of school, please let the office know.

PHE STRIP FOR GRADE 9 & 10

At R.E. Mountain, PHE gym strip is mandatory for all students. Students are able to wear their own gym attire.

PAC DONATIONS

Donations to the REMSS Parent Advisory Council (PAC) can be made through SchoolCash Online. These funds support school programs like the Tough Eagle/Pep Rally events, and other opportunities for student support. Thank you for supporting our REMSS community.

In addition to donating to the PAC, we encourage families who are able to consider donating to our Vulnerable Student Fund which runs on donations from the community to support REMSS students and families in need.

STUDENT USE OF PERSONAL DIGITAL DEVICES

There is a procedure in Langley that gives direction for how to best support our students.

- Teachers will be co-constructing and communicating clearly how cell phones could be used in their class.
 - For example: students may be able to use cell phones to access:
 - Research for a project
 - Class Kahoot
 - School Surveys
 - Microsoft Teams for Instructional Resources
 - MySchoolDay App
 - Educational Apps – ie. Sora, Calculator, DuoLingo, etc.
- Otherwise, it is expected that during hours of instruction, phones should be away. Cell phones should never be out in washrooms or change rooms.

For the purposes of supporting the above restrictions of personal digital devices, interventions should be progressive, and may include:

- a. A verbal reminder to the student;
- b. The personal digital device being collected by staff and returned to the student at the end of the school day;
- c. A phone call or email to the parent/guardian to support the student in the appropriate use of digital devices while at school;
- d. The requirement that any personal digital devices not be brought to a school for a set period of time;
- e. Other interventions, as deemed appropriate by the Administration.

Should you have any questions about these procedures, please reach out to a member of the school administration.

TRAFFIC AND PARKING

As our community is aware, the area around Peter Ewart Middle School and R.E. Mountain Secondary is very busy during school days. With our 8:00am and 9:10am start times, we have worked to reduce the amount of traffic congestion in our area. While drop off times will be improved, we encourage families to pick up their students off site at the end of the day as line ups to leave our property are lengthy.

We encourage students to walk or bike to school. We will have more information out about student and community parking in a separate email prior to the start of school.

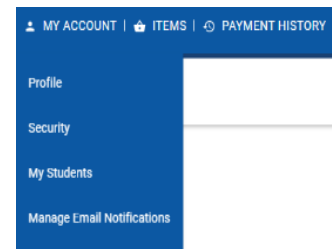
