Win \$1000 with Youth WORK!

Award criteria:

- Be registered as an apprentice by Langley School District
- Graduate with a Dogwood Diploma or Adult Dogwood
- Complete the four Youth WORK in Trades courses
- Maintain a C+ average or better in Grade 12 courses
- Have at least 900 work hours reported to SkilledTradesBC by August 31 after the school year the student turns 19

Student Requirements

- Have parent/guardian permission
- Be 15-19 years old
- Be working or previously worked in one of the 100 SkilledTradesBC (formerly ITA BC) regulated trades
